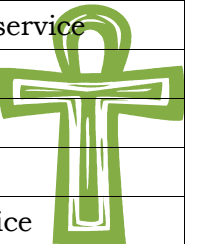

### Family Faith Sharing Question: September 4 ☩23 Sunday in Ordinary Time ☩ Matthew 18:15-20

Too often we hear the word "community" and think that it means only the church that we go to -- we don't to see the larger picture. In today's Gospel reading from Matthew, we learn that early followers of Jesus sometimes found themselves in conflict and disagreement. Jesus talks to them about forgiving one another and tells them how members of the church community can help each other reconcile with one another. In this passage, Matthew also reminds us that Jesus is in our midst whenever we gather in his name -- which means that as we gather together in prayer, Jesus is with us. *Jesus rejected the idea of, "An eye for an eye...a tooth for a tooth," because he wants us to learn how to relate with one another as God relates to us. But this is often hard for us! Why do you think the idea of "payback" can still be such a struggle for us? Can you think of a time when you wanted to "get even" with someone? Talk about what happened.* *Jesus calls us to be "one" with the members of our Church community. How does the presence of Jesus help us do this?*

**FOOD FOR THOUGHT:** In the Gospel readings of this weekend and next we will hear that the work of forgiveness and reconciliation does not come easily. This week Jesus insists that we must seek reconciliation first by seeking out the one who has harmed us. Only then do we bring it to the larger community. Reconciliation is hard work, something to reflect on as- we also celebrate Labor Day. While the holiday gives us a chance to relax, we can never take a break from fostering a spirit of unity and harmony. Reconciliation is our work as baptized Christians.
